**CLAN NOTES: PACKETS WILL BE SENT TO THE ABOVE ADDRESS UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.** Clans submitting an application must be part of a **recognized and organized Scottish Clan or Sept.** Clans are not permitted to sell any items except copies of Research Papers and other items specific to their clan. **NO FOOD ITEMS OF ANY KIND MAY BE SOLD AT ANY CLAN BOOTH.** If you sell any non-permitted items, your clan will not be allowed to return the following year and/or until your clan changes representatives. By signing and submitting this

form, you are agreeing to these requirements. **NO ELECTRIC COOLING DEVICES, OPEN FIRES, GAS, AND/OR CHARCOAL GRILLS OR BURNERS OF ANY KIND MAY BE USED.**

**Parking permits:** Clans will each be issued two (2) official PSFA parking permits. Additional permits can be purchased ahead of time or at the time of your arrival for \$5 for three (3) more permits. Permits must be displayed clearly in the vehicle's front windshield. Vehicles without permits will not be allowed to park in reserved parking areas adjacent to the park and will be subject to towing at owner's expense if parked without a permit.

**Friday night Ceilidh:** Friday night we will host a Ceilidh from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm in the park. We will continue on Saturday with Bandstand performances throughout the day and into the late afternoon when the festival officially ends around 8 pm.

**General Notes & Information: You are required to be set up by Friday at 5 pm and remain set up until 7 pm on Saturday night.** Anyone offering items for sale other than information (i.e., genealogy & historical research) is **REQUIRED** to fill out a State Tax Form before setting up for the Festival. If you need electricity, you are required to supply your own extension cord (50 ft. or less). **Payson City charges \$20 for each electrical cord you use.** Make checks for electricity payable to **City of Payson** and send them in with your application. Vehicles may use the asphalt roadways within the park to unload equipment and supplies. **For safety reasons, PLEASE HAVE ALL VEHICLES OUT OF THE PARK BY 7:30 am Saturday.** The Police will enforce! A Friday afternoon set-up is encouraged. **ALL sleep tents must be removed before 7:00 am Saturday.** For those of you who have RV's, trailers and other large vehicles, you may park in the lot just east of the park. Please let us know the length of your unit so we can make sure there is a spot for you. There are no hookups and, obviously, no dumping is allowed. Any exceptions with regard to RV's will be evaluated on an individual basis. **ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED from being sold or consumed in any manner during festival dates on park premises as well as all other illegal substances. DOGS & CATS are allowed if kenneled. NO REPTILES, BIRDS, NON DOMESTICATED ANIMALS or other PETS allowed.**

A fee of \$35.00 will be charged on all returned checks and may disqualify you as a participant. All fees are Non-Refundable. Upon receipt of payment and approval of the application form by PSFA, a map of the site will be forwarded to you with your location noted for you.

Clans must be prepared to attend their space for the full duration of the Games. Leaving early or arriving late must be pre-approved by PSFA. Clans may not park on the premises except to load and unload items before and after the event. There is parking available for clans and vendors in the parking lot on the north side of the park off 2<sup>nd</sup> south and in the lot to the east of the park. **Vehicles without parking permits showing in front window will be towed at owners' expense.** Cash flow is the responsibility of the clan.

Clans may set up on Friday between 7 am – 3 pm and Saturday before 7 am. You are required to remain set up on Saturday until 7 pm. Unless setting up, all vehicles must leave the grounds by 3 pm on Friday and 7:30 am Saturday. You can break down after 7 pm on Saturday evening. You are expected to be completely off the park premises by 10 pm Saturday. Clans must provide their own table coverings and sun/rain/wind protection. Clans are responsible for removing their garbage to the dumpsters outside the park perimeters on either the north or south side of the park. Please leave the trash cans inside the park for patron usage. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the

grass areas ever! You must keep your vehicles on the paved areas. Absolutely **NO CAMPING** allowed on the athletic field Friday night—your tent will be removed with or without your approval. **Failure to comply with the aforementioned requirements will jeopardize any opportunity for you or your organization to be allowed to participate at Payson Scottish Festival events this year or in the future.**

There will be **absolutely NO PARKING along 200 South between Main Street and 100 East.** This area is for food vendors and serves as an access to PSFA Board Members and City of Payson personnel involved with the festival as well as Ceilidh and Bandstand performers. Any vehicle in this area must have a legitimate PSFA parking permit or it will be towed. These will be a different color than clan and vendor permits.
